

School Fees

To help budget for the upcoming school year, we have outlined <u>some possible fees</u> your school may charge. ASSIST students receive scholarships from their schools which covers tuition, and room and board (for students attending boarding schools). There may be additional fees for which you will be responsible, and these <u>fees vary by school</u>. We advise you budget **US** \$1800 - \$2500 for expenses during the school year, and to contact your school to inquire if you are responsible for any of the fees listed below.

Many schools have these types of required fees/charges:

- Accident insurance
- Health services
- Technology fees
- Uniforms
- Transportation
- Activity Fee/Class trips

Charges specific to a boarding or day school:

- Boarding schools
 - o Room Deposit
 - o Key Deposit
 - o Bookstore Deposit
 - o Guardianship fee
- Day Schools
 - o Lunch Fee

Elective Costs (not required; optional and within your control):

- Intercession/Interim
- Athletic fees
- Various testing
- Course fees
- Yearbook
